Library use soul automation software from Inflibnet. All software models are run successfully i.e. Acquisition, Catalogue Circulation, Serial OPAC and Administration. All data entry of old books is completed with barcoding. Library has generated library membership card with barcoding. Back volume periodical entry is under process. Newly purchase books are entered regularly.
